Liverpool Access Committee

The committee was established to provide advice to Council which will effectively improve and alleviate access difficulties experienced by people with a disability in Liverpool.

Liverpool Access Committees members support Council in making Liverpool City an accessible community. They identify barriers to access and make recommendations to ensure Liverpool residents fully participate in community life and contribute to decisions that impact on their lives.

The committee raises issues associated with access and recommends actions and solutions, actively participates in the development of Council's Disability Inclusion Action Plan, provides advice as required on access issues and liaises with Council in relation to access issues.

MLAK (Master Locksmith Association Key)






















The Master Locksmith Association Key (MLAK) is a master key that fits into specially designed locks, allowing access to public toilets and enabling people with a mobility difficulty to access public toilet facilities throughout New South Wales.

The MLAK is free of charge and is available upon request to eligible residents of Liverpool Local Government Area. To be eligible for an MLAK key, you must be a person with disability, or their carer, or have a written authority from your doctor or disability support organisation.
