# LIVERPOOL'S ECONOMY DEFIES COVID-19

Liverpool City Council recorded impressive economic growth across the Liverpool Local Government Area in 2020, despite the negative effects of COVID-19.

Figures from national economic modeling tool, economy.id reveal an increase in Gross Regional Product from \$11 billion in 2019 to \$13.03 billion in 2020.

The Council's resilience packages for local businesses helped many stay afloat and nearly 500 new businesses opened. The number of local businesses increased from 17,508 in 2019 to 17,962 in 2020.

Liverpool Mayor Wendy Waller said Council's strategies to support local businesses will continue.

## LIVERPOOL COMMEMORATES BICENTENARY OF PIONEERS' MEMORIAL PARK



Liverpool City Council observed the 200-year anniversary of the historic cemetery, Liverpool Pioneers' Memorial Park, in a ceremony on Tuesday 27 April.

First established as the second European burial ground in Liverpool, in 1821, the Liverpool Pioneers' Memorial Park was used as the main burial site in the area until 1958.
