LOCAL UPDATES

CITY CENTRE GROWS UP

The Liverpool CBD is about to grow upwards if current DAs approved and under assessment translate into buildings over the next few years.

With Westfield proposing a new tower on Elizabeth Street, Binah Developments further up the street is also proposing a mixed use tower of over 30 storeys and with another hotel (22 storeys) and mixed use commercial towers (12 storeys), proposed for the south of the CBD, Liverpool is rapidly transitioning towards being Sydney's next CBD.

Combined with the recent approval of a 23 storey commercial tower at 277 Bigge Street, the CBD skyline is set to be transformed over coming years.

WESTERN SYDNEY AIRPORT

Western Sydney Airport has announced the five shortlisted teams competition to design a passenger terminal for Sydney's proposed second airport.

The selected team will be required to have a vision for the airport to be developed in multiple stages. Stage one will include a 3.7 kilometre runway and facilities for up to 10 million passengers annually. Further stages will accommodate a projected 82 million annual passengers by 2060.

The winning design is expected to be selected by the end of the year. The airport is due to open in 2026.

CSIRO - GENERATION STEM PILOT IN LIVERPOOL

Council has partnered with CSIRO to pilot a project-based learning program for Year 9 students beginning in Term 3.

Generation STEM engages local high school students in student-led Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) based projects to address challenges faced by the wider community.

This initiative is launching in Western Sydney where major industry developments will generate 200,000 new STEM jobs in the region over the next 20 years. Generation STEM empowers local young people with the relevant STEM skills to pursue a STEM career. The ambition is to build a strong community of STEM-capable citizens to fuel local industry.

Western Sydney businesses that use STEM innovation in the workplace are invited to be involved and inspire local students to pursue a STEM career pathway.

Call for EOIs for pop-ups

Council is calling for EOIs from businesses and relevant organisations and services for fun, innovative and engaging pop-up activities to accompany the laneway activations and engage visitors during this time.

Council will provide funding of up to \$2,000 for businesses to deliver their pop-up. The funding must be used for the material cost of delivering the pop-up, eg. props, equipment hire, styling, etc. It cannot be used for staff time or any standard business operation costs.
