General Requirements

General information

- Council requires minimum ten (10) working days to assess the application and to provide approval following satisfaction of all Council requirements.
- All street lights are to be Endeavour Energy (EE) approved LED lights as per PLDB requirements on EE approved poles.
- Coated, except multifunction, poles are not acceptable.
- EE approved Macarthur multifunction poles with black powder coated are allowed. The locations are to be decided in consultation with Council. Each multifunction poles are to have three conduits.
- All posts with 'P' category lighting are to be installed adjacent property boundaries. Poles with 'V' category

Processing and approval

- The immediate processing of requests is not guaranteed and Council will not be responsible for the consequences caused by late applications or insufficient information.

Applicant's responsibility and compliance

- The owner is responsible for compliance to meet Endeavour Energy requirement including installation and commissioning of the street lights to EE satisfaction.
